

STALLHOLDER CONDITIONS & AGREEMENT

Drummoyne Fun Day Pre-loved Market

Organiser: Communities for Communities

Event Date: 8th June 2025

Location: Drummoyne Oval

1. Stall Details

- Each stallholder will be allocated a 3m x 3m space.
- Stallholders must bring their own picnic mat or suitcases, chairs, tables, and any display racks or covers they need.
- No furniture or shelter will be provided.
- All items and displays must remain within the allocated space and must not obstruct public walkways or adjacent stalls.

2. Bump-In and Bump-Out

- Bump-in time: 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM.
- No vehicle access after 12:30 PM. Stallholders arriving late must carry their items from nearby parking areas.
- Bump-out: After the event concludes at [Insert End Time]. All items and rubbish must be removed by [Insert Pack-Up Time].

3. What Can Be Sold

- Only second-hand or pre-loved goods are permitted.
- ❖ **Children's Products:** Items like baby dummies, bicycles, and children's toys must meet mandatory safety standards. Selling products that don't comply can lead to penalties.
- ❖ **Clothing:** Must have appropriate care labels and comply with flammability standards.
- ❖ **Electrical Goods:** Certain electrical items, termed 'declared articles' (e.g., heaters, toasters), require safety approval before sale. Selling unapproved items can result in fines up to \$825,000 or imprisonment.
- **No food, drink, or new retail items allowed.**
- Stallholders are responsible for ensuring all items are safe, appropriate, and comply with relevant laws.

4. Safety and Setup

- Stallholders must ensure their setup is safe and clean throughout the event.

- No power supply will be provided

5. Liability

- The organiser is not liable for any loss, theft, or damage to goods or personal belongings.
- Children at stalls must be supervised at all times.

6. Behaviour and Compliance

- Stallholders must follow all instructions from event organisers and staff.
- The organiser reserves the right to remove any stallholder for failure to comply, disruptive behaviour, or unsafe conduct.

7. Application and Refund Policy

- The organiser reserves the right to accept or reject any stallholder application.
- Stall tickets are non-refundable but transferable to another person.
- A full refund will be issued if the event is cancelled due to wet weather or other circumstances beyond the organiser's control.
- Stall placement is determined by the organiser and is not negotiable.
